What is Age Action?

Age Action is Ireland's leading charity working to improve the quality of life of all older people and their carers.

We have members of all ages. Many are older people, some are carers, others are professionals, voluntary groups, statutory bodies and private firms.

We want to change attitudes, and tackle ageism in all forms. We believe older people should have the same rights as any other age group, and should not be judged by their chronological age.

We promote positive ageing, and organise Positive Ageing Week each year.



Getting Started is a volunteer based information and communications technology (ICT) programme that will offer older people the opportunity to learn how to use computers under the direction of trained volunteers.

How Does it Work?

- Courses run for 2 hours per week for 8 weeks.
- Courses are run through public libraries and sheltered housing projects so that you do not have to travel far to learn.
- Tutors are volunteers who are carefully selected and trained.
- There is a high pupil teacher ratio ensuring you receive the maximum support that you need while learning.
- We organise a *Circle of Friends* concept which encourages learners to invite their neighbours and friends to get involved and stay connected.
- Courses are free of charge
